Low Prices Encourage Building



This pretty little stucco bungalow (with wrought ironwork supporting a lamp over the side driveway is easily capable of stirring one's imagination. It seems to belong to some country scene with flowers and shrubs surrounding it, and trees sheltering it from the elements. There is something in the appearance which suggests peace and friendliners. 
