PLANS ARE DISCUSSED

Blue Print of Proposed Library Building to Be Posted—Monthly Meeting Last Night

Plans for the proposed new library building here were again brought up at last night's regular monthly meeting of the library board and it was decided to have same blue-printed and a copy posted in the library for public inspection.

The meeting decided to order \$200 worth of new books and \$30 was authorized for the duplicate pay section.

The gift of two books from the Christian Science Society was reported—one "The Life of Mary Baker Eddy," the other, "What Mary Baker Eddy told Arthur Brisbane."

Librarian's Report The following statistics for the month of March were reported by the librarian, Miss Alice Cruikshank:

Circulation—Fiction, 4415; duplicate pay, 207; non-fiction, 795; juvenile, 163; total, 7047.

The library was open 22 days during the month and the average number of books borrowed per day was 320.3. There were 54 new borrowers during the month while 28 were cancelled, making a net gain of 26 and a total of 3302 borrowers using the library.

Six books were received by gift and 74 were purchased, or a total of 80 new books. Sixty volumes were discarded, making a net gain of 20 or a total of 7803 volumes now on the shelves of the institution.
