At the recent convention of life insurance men in New York the president of one of the big companies gave an address in which he said:

"While standing accused of exceeding all their former speed, records in extravagance and reckless spending, the American people are nevertheless buying this year about eight billion dollars. of old line life insurance, or two and one-half times the amount they acquired in 1914.
