#### Recipe for Baked Custard

2 cups St. Charles Milk 1/4 teaspoon salt  
2 cups water 4-6 eggs beaten  
1/2 cup sugar 1 teaspoon Vanilla  
Few gratings nutmeg

Dilute milk with water and bring to scalding point—do not boil. Mix sugar, salt and beaten eggs. Pour the hot milk, a little at a time, over the egg mixture, stirring to blend thoroughly.
