### LONG TRIP IS PLANNED

Two Seattle Men Will Use Canoe, Pony and Automoble in Traversing Yukon and Alaska

DAWSON, June 24:-Lyman Culver and James Cassady of Seattle, will attempt a 3,000-mile journey this summer by canoe, pony and automobile through the Yukon and Alaska. They have already arrived at Ketchikan and will shortly begin their long overland trek.

A 16-foot canoe, powered with an overboard engine, will take them to Skagway, where they will ship over the famous Chilkoot Pass to the headwaters of the Yukon. There they will start their main trip, travelling nearly 2500 miles by sail, paddle an dmotor to Nome, on the west coast of Alaska.

They will camp at night along the river banks, but the canoe is arranged so that one can sleep while the other steers in case they want to travel day and night.


