LET WOMEN IN Y.M.C.A.

Resolution of Revolutionary Character Coming Up at Toronto Conference

TORONTO, August 6.—When the international legislative body of the world Y.M.C.A. convenes in Cleveland, following the world conferences on work in Toronto, there will be presented a resolution of revolutionary character, having to do with the relation of women to the Y.M.C.A.

At Philadelphia women have been admitted to Y.M.C.A. membership, not merely to the Y.M.C.A. women's auxiliaries which aid the work of branches. This is not comprehended in the general constitution. It involves the wide question of administration as well as of activities. At the world convention in Cleveland a resolution will, it is expected, be presented by the Philadelphia Y.M.C.A., suggesting such constitutional change as would regularize this procedure and there will probably be extensive debate on the subject.

The opposition, it seems likely, will not centre in any way on the fitness or qualifications of women for recognition, and will not imply anti-feminine partiality, but will deal with the question of whether such development is in keeping with the genius of the Y.M.C.A. as an organization of and for boys and young men.

DETAILS OF FIRE

Further Particulars of Conflagration in Usk Hotel Property

USK, Aug. 6.—Fred Michaud, Forest Branch lookout on Thornhill Mountain, reported to the Terrace office on Saturday that a fire had broken out in Usk.

Investigation revealed a fire had started in the power house of the Shackleton Hotel, and had spread to the woodshed attached.

Fortunately, the wind was blowing from the south, carrying the flames away from the hotel, 50 feet to the south of the blaze.

The residents of Usk responded to the need, and bucket brigades were formed, in which the work of the ladies was on outstanding feature.

The fire was confined to the two buildings, and was not allowed to spread up the hill to the north of them, thus removing the danger from the Stewart property.

The Forest Branch equipment went up after the passenger train had passed, and the pump was used to wet down the surrounding bush, ensuring the complete safety of the other properties.
