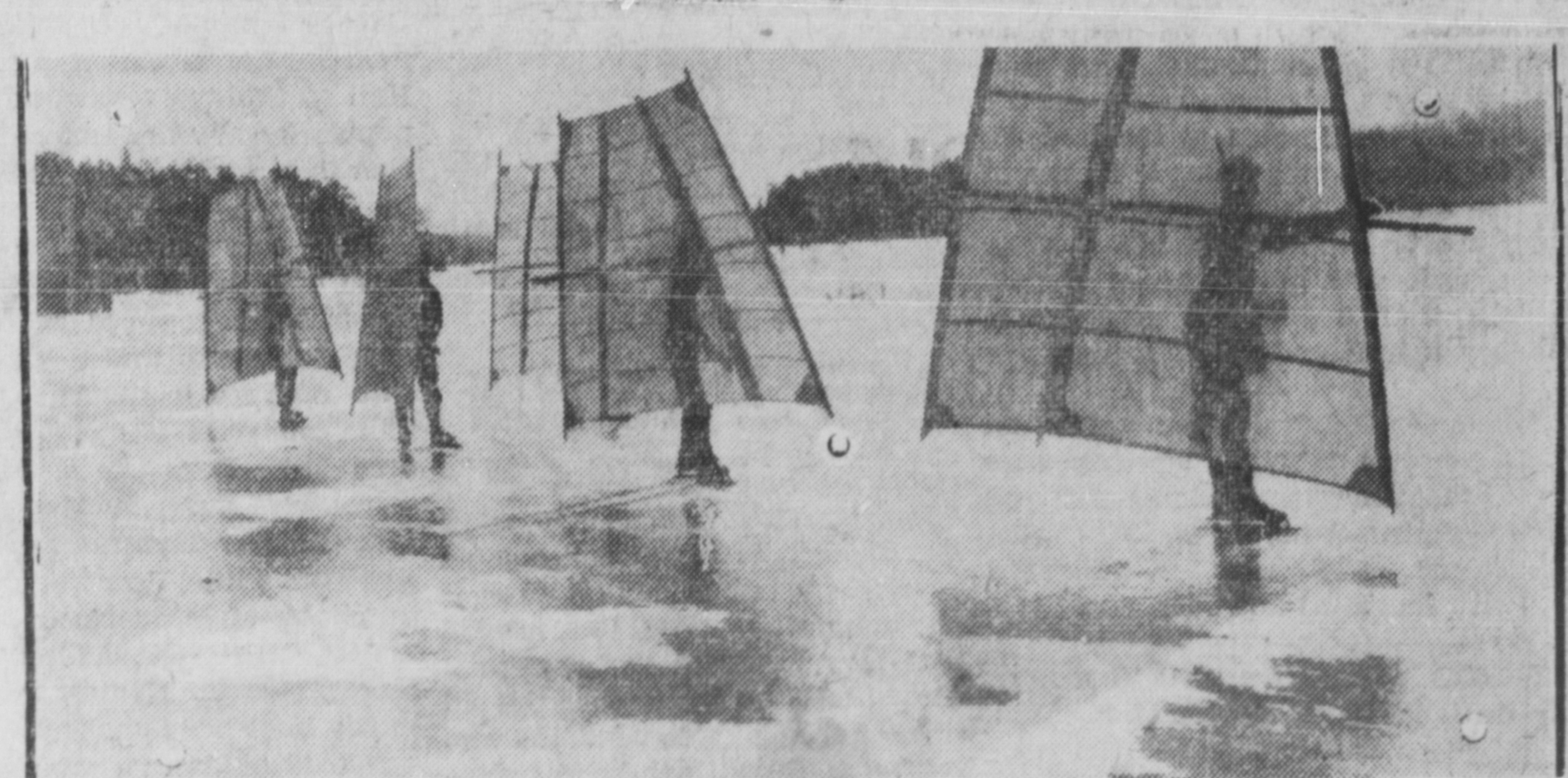

The Council of the Corporation of the City of Prince Rupert intends to complete the grading and macadam wearing surface on Eleventh Avenue from Conrad Street to the end of the graded road in McClymont Park as a local improvement, and intends to specially assess the cost upon the land abutting directly on the work, except such portion of the cost as is incurred at street intersections.
