The company in question, ank Waterhouse & Company of enada Ltd. was organized in 1918 the late Frank Waterhouse, a tive of Cheshire, England, and em information supplied by the logistrar of Companies, Victoria c. it is shown that 'this is a !! empany incorporated under the ews of the Dominion of Canada.' ts head office is situated at 926-8 logers Building. Vancouver, B.C. nd there are no branches elsethere in Canada or the United states. The majority of the Comany's directors are Canadians. nd one-half the principal stockoliers are also of Canadian or British birth, and resident chiefly vancouver. The company owns ive vessels, all of which are emloyed in coast-wise freighting etween Pritish Columbia ports. ecluding Queen Charlotte Islands. vest coast of Vancouver Island, and to Seattle, Tacoma and other lugat Sound ports. All vessels are Canadian registry, two were built in British Corumbia, one in Ontario, and two in England. The paragement of the company is enrely in the hands of Canadians, nd the vessels are manned by Caacian officers and crews. The manager of Frank Waterhouse & o. of Canada Ltd. is a member t the board of trustees of the

ancouver Merchants Exchange, nd is the representative of that pard for coastwise shipping. "It may perhaps be of interest [ state that the Montreal Daily tar of March 29th, 1932, gave the resent distribution of C. P. R. tock, by countries as follows:

Held in the United Kingdom. 9.97 per cent. Held in the United States, 20.78

Yet, surely, no one would suggest hat the C.P.R. was a 'foreign' mpany?' It may therefore be afely said, that the Frank Waterhouse Co. of Canada Ltd, is a largpercentage Canadian owned han any steamship company oprating on the British Columbia

"Contrary to suggestions made" n the report of the trade and mmerce committee, the Waterlouse vessels have, when required. Jurchased their provisions, fuel, and water at this port. They pay becessary harbor dues and customs ees, and have provided considerble revenue to the Canadian Namal Railways by payment of rail wharfage charges on cargo tidled by their system, and os their wharf.

Personally, I deeply regret that should have been necessary for furnish your committee with this information. However, if he parties who started this conroversy, apparently in an effort o further their own ends, had equainted themselves with facts, and had also considered for one moment the vast amount of American capital invested in every form of Canadian industry, as well s in Deminion and Provincial gov ernment bonds. I feel sure that tatements would not have been nade in public which might have prejudiced the position of the ompany in question, in the eyes the shipping public."
