### Liabilities of **McPhee Estate**

City Will Have to Meet Obligations of \$2100 Before Assets Can Be Transferred

Liabilities, including doctor bills, funeral expenses, etc., and totalling \$2108, will have to be met before the executors can transfer the estate of the late Jus. N. McFhee to the city, the council was informed last night by City Solicitor E. F. Jones. In his will, Mr. McPhee, who died about a year ago, bequeathed his entire estate to the city for the benefit of children's playgrounds. Assets include three houses in the city, bringing a total of \$60 per month in rent, and a boat of doubtful value as well as some \$142 on deposit in bank. The matter was referred to the finance committee and city solicitor for further investigation and report
