ALL IS QUIET AT VANCOUVER

Four of the Prisoners are Sentenced

(Canadian Press Despatch)
Vancouver, June 7.—Four of the seven men arrested by the Vancouver police during the disturbance, following the strikes in the building trades, were sentenced to three months' hard labor without the option of a fine by the police magistrate this morning. It is expected that this will act as a deterrent from any future attempts at creating disturbance.

Not Union Men

None of the men sentenced are union men, and had no part in the strike. They were men who went into the matter voluntarily, and were trying to urge the strikers on to create public disturbances.

Situation Unchanged

In every other respect the situation is unchanged. The men of the building trades have the union bricklayers are out, but no attempt is being made to interfere with the non-union men at work. The street railway traffic is going on as before, and it is now looked on as unlikely that the street
