


been warm with some good rains which will improve feed and pasture conditions. Heavy hail visited parts of the Three Hills and Stettler subdivisions and caused considerable damage. Cutting is well advanced and threshing is expected to begin in a day or so. Wheat is grading well but outruns show no uniformity. North Central Alberta reports weather warm and dry and the Camrose. Vegreville subdivisions expect yields of from 16 to 25 bushels to the acre.

In the Peace River country harvesting has started and since commencement weather has been fine and warm with only a few showers in some districts. All crops are in good condition and no damage is reported from hail, drought or in-

The liquidation of cattle from drought areas in southern parts of Saskatchewan and Manitoba has depressed prices. All classes except good quality, grass fed butcher cattle showing considerable kill are lower than a week ago. The outlet for these thin cattle is limited and many of them are going to the packers as canners. Lowered receipts of hops has strengthened the price and this strength should continue for some little time.
