

MAKE IMPORTANT FOSSIL MAMMALS FIND



CANADIAN GOVERNMENT PALEONTOLOGISTS MAKE DISCOVERY

Dr. L. S. Russell and Dr. R. T. D. Wickenden of the Geological Survey Department of Mines, Ottawa, have announced the discovery of a new locality for fossil mammals in Canada. The two government paleontologists, working near Swift Current, Sask., have obtained a small collection of fossil teeth proved to represent animals of the late eocene times, which have not previously been found in Canada. Such fossils have been found in Utah and more recently in South California. Teeth of a rhinoceros, of titianotheres (large horn-bearing beasts), of a three-toed horse (primitive antelope-like creatures and a fore-runner of the squirrels) are included in the find. A single rabbit tooth is one of the oldest known records of such animals. In the above layout is shown (1) a titanotheris, a large horn-bearing animal and (2) a sabre-tooth tiger pulling down a pre-historic horse.
