## Rainfall Extends To Yukon Country

Three Days of Continuous Precipitation Between Whitehorse and Dawson Reported

Like elsewhere in the north, the usually sunny Yukon Territory is having rather exceptional weather this summer insofar as heavy precipitation is concerned. Government Telegraphs reported this morning that there had been three days of continuous rainfall between Whitehorse and Dawson.

The daily weather report for the interior and coast, showing continued unsettled weather, was as follows:

Anyox—Cloudy, west wind, 51.  
Stewart—Raining, calm, 52.  
Hazelton—Cloudy, calm, 56.  
Smithers—Cloudy, calm, 53.  
Burns Lake—Clear, calm, 59.  
Dead Tree Point—Overcast, calm; barometer, 30.30; temperature, 56; sea smooth.  
Triple Island—Overcast, moderate southwest wind; sea smooth.  
Langara Island—Overcast, light southerly wind, sea smooth.

## SOCKEYE FISHING

Improvement in Lower Part of District—Skeena and Naas Still Light

Fishing has much improved at Rivers Inlet, Bella Coola and other points down the coast according to an official report received from there and, if the weather improves, fishing should be good on the Skeena within a few days.

Rivers Inlet reports an average of 75 fish to the boat Sunday night and 66 on Monday. Bella Coola has an average catch of 75 fish to the boat.

On the Skeena the catch Sunday night was only 12 and the Naas 18. Only a few boats ventured into Chatham Straits during the past two days as a gale was blowing there which made it almost impossible to operate.


