TO THE HONORABLE THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA, PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED:

pendent people, in whom resides the right of self determination, do hereby vigorously protest against the action of the Radio Commission of Canada in censoring or attempting to censor and exclude from public broadcast radio lectures on matters pertaining to the Bible and of public interest, and particularly the lectures of J. F. Rutherford, pertaining to divine prophecy. We have faith in the Bible as the Word of God, and that it was written for the instruction of man. Many sincere persons claim that the Bible prophecies apply particularly to our day and bear direct relationship to the present world distress, and disclose God's remedy for relief. We are entitled to hear these questions publicly discussed free from all censor, otherwise our freedom is taken away. Those who object, or who may be offended by such lectures, may turn their radio dials and decline to hear.

We, therefore, demand that the Dominion Parliament take immediate action, removing from the Radio Commission the power to censor, hinder or prevent such lectures by radio and that the people be left free to determine what they may or may not hear. Men of world-wide repute and eminently qualified to explain the Bible, such as we believe Rutherford is, can be helpful to the people and we demand that our radio stations be permitted to publicly broadcast his lectures. The question is: Shall the people continue to enjoy freedom or shall a few men deprive them of their God-given rights?
