### TELLS ABOUT CONVEYANCES

Reid McLennan Gives Interesting Address on Legal Subject at Rotary Club Luncheon

At the regular weekly luncheon of the Prince Rupert Rotary Club yesterday Reid McLennan of the firm of Fisher & McLennan gave a very interesting address on conveyancing. He sketched the history of holding of land titles show that at one time all land was held under the feudal system. It was parcelled out among the followers of the King who required military and other services in return. Should there be a failure in the succession the property went back to the king.

The speaker told of the different kinds of freeholds, explained what was necessary in a deed of conveyance or any other deed and showed that each word had a special significance.

The Land Registry Act of British Columbia made registration the chief feature in any title. The vendor was compelled to give a title that could be registered. Possession was no title. The deed had to be made on a prescribed form and the title was assured by the Government on payment of a fee given at the time of securing the indefeasible title.

At the conclusion President Woodland thanked the club's youngest member for his excellent address.
