### Will Dedicate New Cathedral

LONDON, Feb. 7:-Two cardinals and at least 40 bishops will attend the laying of the foundation stone or the new Catholic Cathedral at Liverpool, which is to take place on Whit Monday. Four acres of the site on Brownlow Hill, where once stood a great gloomy poorhouse, have been cleared. Sir Edwin Lutyens, architect of the new cathedral, has designed a magnificent altar, which will be used not only at the laying of the foundation stone, but will serve for years after until it is eventually replaced by the high altar of the cathedral.
