The Armour Salvage Co.'s big power tug Salvage Princess yesterday afternoon, came off the pontoons at the local dry dock where she has been for the past two or three weeks receiving annual overhaul and having repairs made to her shaft with which trouble developed recently. The Princess is now in shipshape to take care of all the activities the season has to offer in the way of work and service.

The Armour Salvage Co.'s derelict snow, which had an arduous job recently in connection with the salvaging of the wrecked halibut boat Livingstone II on the west coast of Dundas Island, also came off the pontoons yesterday after having had her bottom painted and repaired.

Dismantling of the vessel including the removal of her Fairbanks-Morse diesel engine having been completed, the hull of the Livingstone II was also removed from the pontoons yesterday. The derelict, which is lashed alongside a scow at present, is to be beached meantime and repairs may be made to the hull next winter.
