RECORD OF RAIN SET

Precipitation of 25.53 Inches Recorded in November Here—Believed All Time High Mark

A new all time record for heavy rainfall in Prince Rupert is believed to have been set up during the month of November this year when the precipitation totalled 25.53 inches. The previous high record for the past six years was 17.46 inches in November last year. There were 16.1 hours of sunshine in November this year as against two hours in November, 1932.

The weather summary for this November, as announced today by R. G. Emmerson, Digby Island, Dominion meteorologist, was as follows:

High barometer at sea level, 30.56 on November 4.
Lowest barometer at sea level, 29.20 on November 20.
Maximum temperature, 56 on November 6.
Minimum temperature, 32 on November 27.
Mean temperature, 43.8.
Total precipitation, 25.53 inches.
Sunshine, 16.1 hours.

Prince Henry and Prince David For Bahamas Service

The Canadian National Steamships liners Prince Henry and Prince David, which have been for the past few years on the Atlantic Coast and have not been running for the past year, will shortly be commissioned in a new ferry service between Nassau, Bahamas, and Miami, Fla. It is an eight-hour run between the two points and a large amount of traffic is reported to have been booked. The service will be started early in the New Year.
