After three busy days, Dr. A. S. Lamb, travelling provincial health officer and chest specialist, is concluding his annual chest clinic at the Prince Rupert General Hospital today. The number of persons examined each day at the clinic was about twenty-five.

Dr. Lamb and Miss Josephine B. Peters R.N., clinic nurse, are leaving on this evening's train for the interior after a tour of which they will proceed to Vancouver. Clinics will be held at such points as Hazelton, Smithers, Burns Lake, Vanderhoof and Prince George.

SUNSHINE INCREASED

Old Sol Generous With His Blessing For Prince Rupert With 265 Hours More Than in 1933

Prince Rupert so far in 1934 has enjoyed more than fifty percent more sunshine than in the first seven months of 1933, the sunshine aggregate for the present year up to the end of July having been 685.5 hours as compared with 420.6 hours in the corresponding period of last year. Precipitation so far this year has totalled 57.20 inches in comparison with 44.25 for the same period last year.

In July this year there were 113 hours of bright sunshine as compared with 55.2 hours in July 1933 while the precipitation for the month just ended amounted to 4.11 inches in comparison with 6.26 inches in the same month last year. The weather summary for July this year was as follows:

Highest barometer reading at sea level, 30.42 on July 1.
Lowest barometer reading at sea level, 29.36 on July 16.
Maximum temperature, 86.5 on July 25.
Minimum temperature, 42 on July 19.
Mean temperature, 53.6.
Sunshine, 113 hours.
Precipitation, 4.11 inches.
