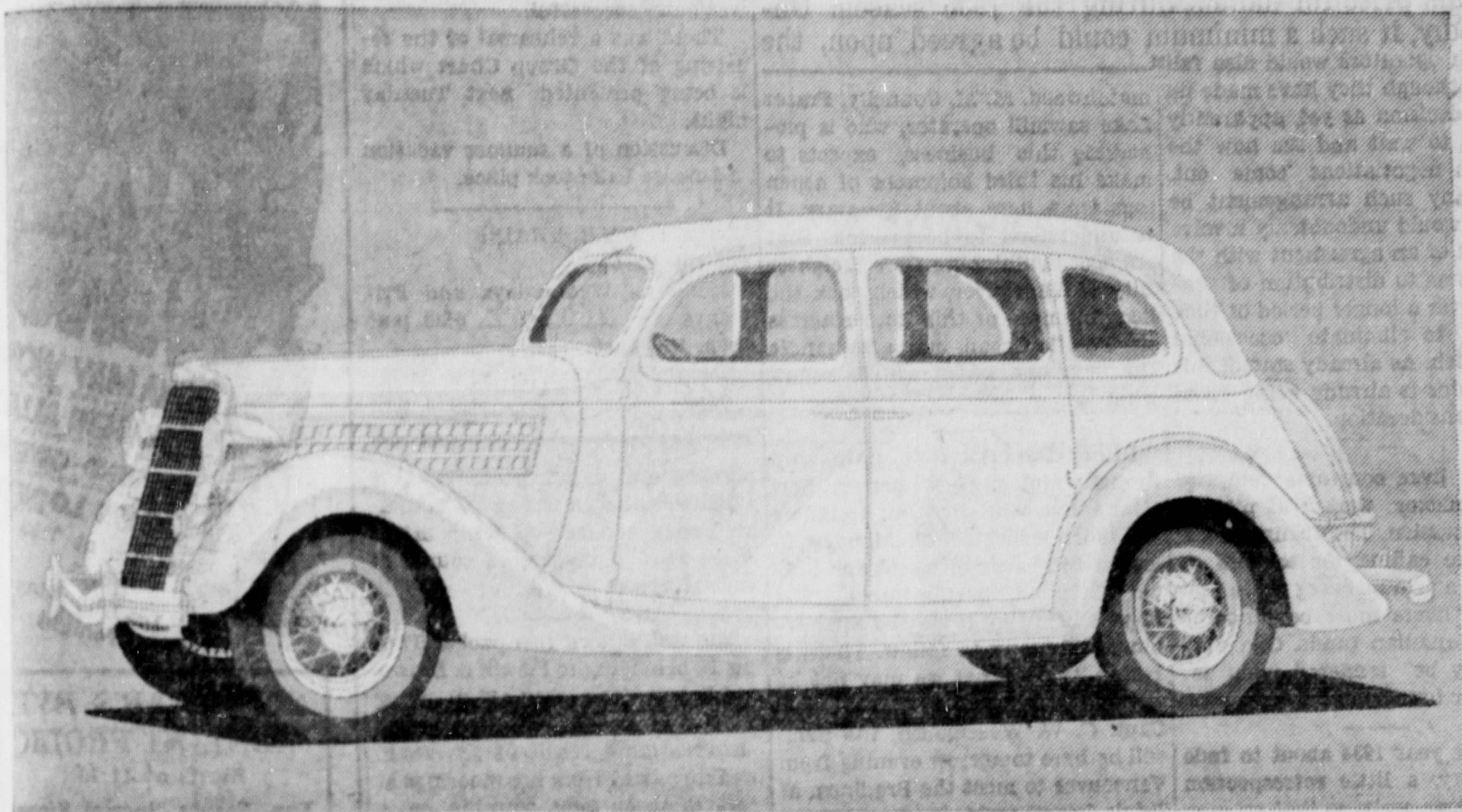
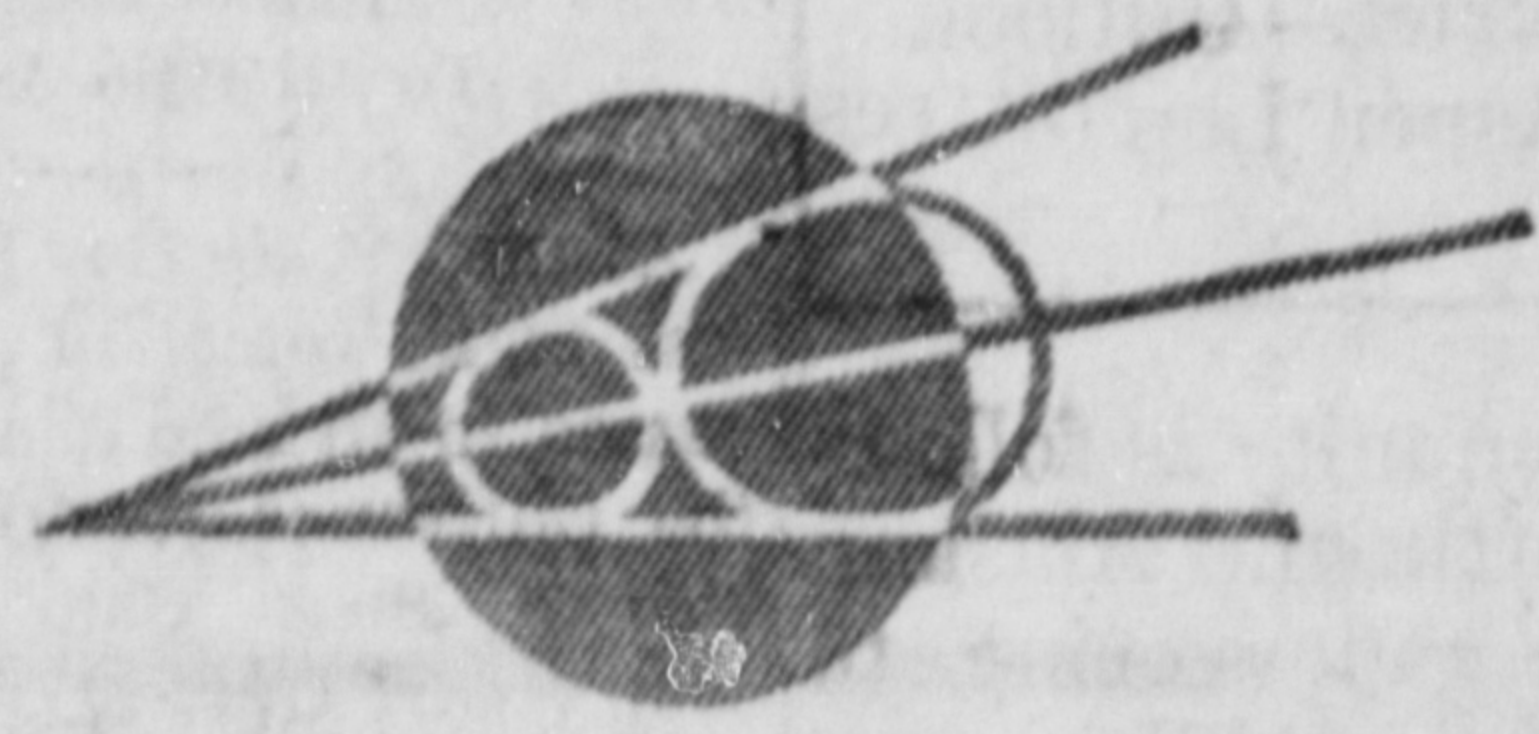


# FORD V-8 FOR 1935
