Erickson sailed by the Prince Rupert last night on his return to Vancouver after a brief visit here, his business having been to make an inspection of the steamer Prince William, which has been tied up at the local dry dock for the last few years and which Canadian National Steamships are offering for sale. Up to the time of leaving the city, Mr. Erickson was uncertain as to whether a tender would be made for the purchase of the ship.

It is understood that no tenders had been submitted for the vessel at the time bids closed recently.

Queen Charlotte Island run between Vancouver and Prince Rupert, keeps people of the Islands posted by radiophone as to her whereabouts and expected times of arrival at her various ports of call is proving a great boon to the Islanders, particularly those at the more isolated points who heretofore have had no means of communication from the vessel.

Some of the settlers have to travel as far as thirty miles to meet the steamer. Often in the past this has meant hours and sometimes days of waiting. Now, however, as a result of the radiophone messages from the ship, these settlers know exactly when to leave their homes in order to meet the vessel. The messages are picked up on the ordinary receiving sets and have been received from as far away as Vancouver.
