**CHAIRMAN IS NAMED**

Dr. A. T. Cameron of Winnipeg Named Head of Biological Board

Changes in the administration of the Biological Board of Canada are reported by John Dybhavn of this city who returned to Prince Rupert yesterday after attending the annual meeting of the board, of which he is a member, in Ottawa recently. Prof. J. P. McMurrich, Toronto, who has been chairman of the board for several years, asked, on account of his health, to be relieved. The request was met and Dr. A. T. Cameron, Winnipeg, was elected chairman in his place. J. J. Cowie was re-elected secretary-treasurer and Dr. W. T. MacClemant, A. Handfield - Whitman, Prof. A. Vachon and Dr. J. P. McMurrich were named members of the executive for the year.

It was intimated at the meeting that the board could hardly expect that any more money would be available for its purposes this year than there was last. In view of this, the board set its plans to continue such investigations as are now in progress insofar as conditions will permit but it is unlikely that any extensions will be undertaken.

Due to new problems which have developed during pink salmon investigations on the Queen Charlotte Islands, it was deemed especially advisable to follow this work up further until certain desired results in connection with these problems have been reached. The meeting heard that pink salmon which had been marked in Massett Inlet had been found all along the coast. Heretofore it had been an
