

Fire at any time is a grim and unwelcome visitor. Those who have suffered through visitation from the Red Demon can best appreciate the plight of the people of the historic gold town of Nome which was all but razed by a disastrous conflagration on Monday. The situation is made the worse by the fact that winter is about to lay its grasp on that far north port and, inside of six weeks, navigation will close, restricting to great extent the possibilities of relief. Even for the very near future supplies are scarce in view of the whole settlement, with its stores and supplies, being virtually wiped out. People of the north and of the frontiers will sympathize with the stricken population of Nome.

#### **Business Period**


