# WHIFFLETS From the Waterfront

Fine Run of Cohoes on Skeena River-Princess Louise in Today -Tanker Imperial Calls.

An unusually good run of cohoes on the Skeena River for this time of year is reported. Five hundred gillnetters are engaged in fishing and are reported to be catching from twenty up to over one hundred fish per boat with numerous boats getting around 60 to 75 fish. Taking into account prices of 43c and 45c per fish, this makes profitable fishing. Two canneries-Inverness and Oceanic-are still in operation on the Skeena River with Sunnyside, although closed itself, taking all the fish it can obtain for delivery to Namu cannery down the coast. The run of chums is still light with pinks over except for an occasional

On a regularly scheduled voyage to Skagway and other Alaska points, C. P. R. steamer Princess Louise, Capt. Thomas Cliff, arrived in port at 8:45 this morning from Vancouver and sailed at 11 a.m. for the north whence she is scheduled to call here next Monday afternoon southbound. The vessel had only 32 passengers aboard of whom three disembarked here while thirteen went north from here aboard her.
