NO-HIT, NO-RUN GAME

BROOKLYN, Sept. 22: (CP)—Paul Dean pitched a no-hit, no-run game for the St. Louis Cardinals against the Brooklyn Dodgers at Ebbets Field here yesterday after his brother, Dizzy Dean, had hurled a three-hit shut-out for the Cards in the first. It was the first no-hit game in either major league since early in 1931 when Wes Ferrell turned in such a performance for the Cleveland Indians.

The New York Giants won over the Braves at Boston but had their margin of leadership over the Cardinals reduced to three games.

Yesterday's Big League scores: National League New York 8, Boston 1. Cincinnati 3-3, Pittsburgh 9-16. St. Louis 13-3, Brooklyn 0-0. One American League game postponed.

WATERFRONT WHIFFS

Date For Closing Area No. 3 Not Yet Set—Skeena Salmon Pack Well Ahead of Last Year—Good Week For Halibut

"The International Fisheries Commission is well pleased that the fish are much more abundant and, at the same time, the fishermen have been making much better financial returns," remarked Dr. Will F. Thomson, director of scientific investigations for the International Fisheries Commission, who arrived in the city yesterday aboard the Prince Rupert from Seattle for a brief visit on official business and will return south tonight on the same vessel. Asked as to when the Commission would close fishing for the season on the banks of Area No. 3, Dr. Thomson said that the date on which the decision as to the date of closing would be made was now in Seattle and it was expected that an announcement would be made shortly.

Having spent all day in the Skeena River loading salmon from various canneries, Union steamer Cardena, Capt. Ernest Georgeson, arrived in port at 12:15 midnight last night from the south and sailed an hour or so later for Vancouver and waypoints.

The deer hunting season has been open for a week now but there has not been much activity among hunters so far and fewer licences than usual have been taken out. Now, however, the tang of winter is beginning to be felt in the air, snow will soon be getting on the slopes of the mountains to force the deer to lower levels and then there should be more interest in the hunting business. The season for the shooting of geese and ducks will open in the western district on October 13, remaining open until January 29. Bird hunting regulations for this season are much the same as in previous years. The bag limit for ducks is not more than twenty in one day with a limit of 150 for the season. The geese limit is ten in a day and fifty in the season.

In a review of business and industrial conditions issued by the Royal Bank of Canada, the optimistic tenor of which has been causing considerable comment, figures compiled regularly each week for the Waterfront Whiffs in regard to halibut landings at this port are referred to show the increase in production this year and the improved general conditions under which the fishermen are operating. The Royal Bank of Canada monthly letter is accepted as one of the most authoritative indices on general conditions in Canada.

The salmon pack on the Skeena River for the 1934 season up to September 15 was 262,312 cases as compared with 175,209 cases up to a corresponding date last year according to official figures. The sock-

to 40 bushels. Clover and alfalfa are weeds which infest their gardens and they cannot grow timothy seed because clover and alfalfa insist on coming up with it. The average yield is over two tons to the acre.

Some of the struggling farmers have been receiving relief from the provincial government but that is because the amount of land is not sufficient yet to provide them with a livelihood at prevailing prices. For that relief they have given labor on the roads which has taken the place of the usual public works appropriations. Roads have been graded but they are sorely in need of gravel surfacing.

McBride is a divisional point on the railway. There is good hunting and fishing in the district. It is surrounded by picturesque mountains. During the past few weeks many mining claims have been recorded there and samples of rich ore are shown to visitors. The place is bound to develop into an important town, growing steadily as the valley is settled. Some day soon I plan to tell more about the town itself.
