



COLLECTIVE CONTROL

Editor, Daily News:-

Your interesting editorial "Hitler and Germany" should wake up certain strata of sleeping politicians who think that all that is necessary is to turn out on election day. Is the education of the youth and the re-education of themselves in line with the modern trend of thoughts and action of no impor-

Everyone must wake up and reaiize that we are undergoing moral as well as a political revolution following the collapse of our economic system.

The economic conditions of our country are such that the masses are exasperated and are ready to listen to anything-even to Marxism although it is 84 years old and ob-

The sponsors of the C. C. F. are trying to revive a dead philosophy. namely Marxism, which has served its great moral purpose—the most complete critic of capitalism.

For the Marxian class antagonism, class clash, class struggle and hatred, the modern world substitutes co-operation of the classes by bringing the forces of production under the control of the state which represents the spirit of the people and is the unique force to interpret national society.


