**CANADA AT WAR 20 YEARS AGO**

veritable maelstrom which had had its immediate source in the Sarajevo murders were drawn Germany, France, Russia, Great Britain and, within a few days, Belgium. Europe became afflicted with a delirium of war fever.

Feverishly pleading to all concerned that they halt their preparations for war, Sir Edward Grey, British foreign secretary, sought in vain to effect a conference of the prospective combatants. Councils of peace went unheeded. The smouldering hatreds and jealousies which had been but indifferently concealed for generations past flared out. The match cast into the European powder magazine a month previously had done its work. The volcano outbreak which had its culmination on August 4 could not be controlled.
