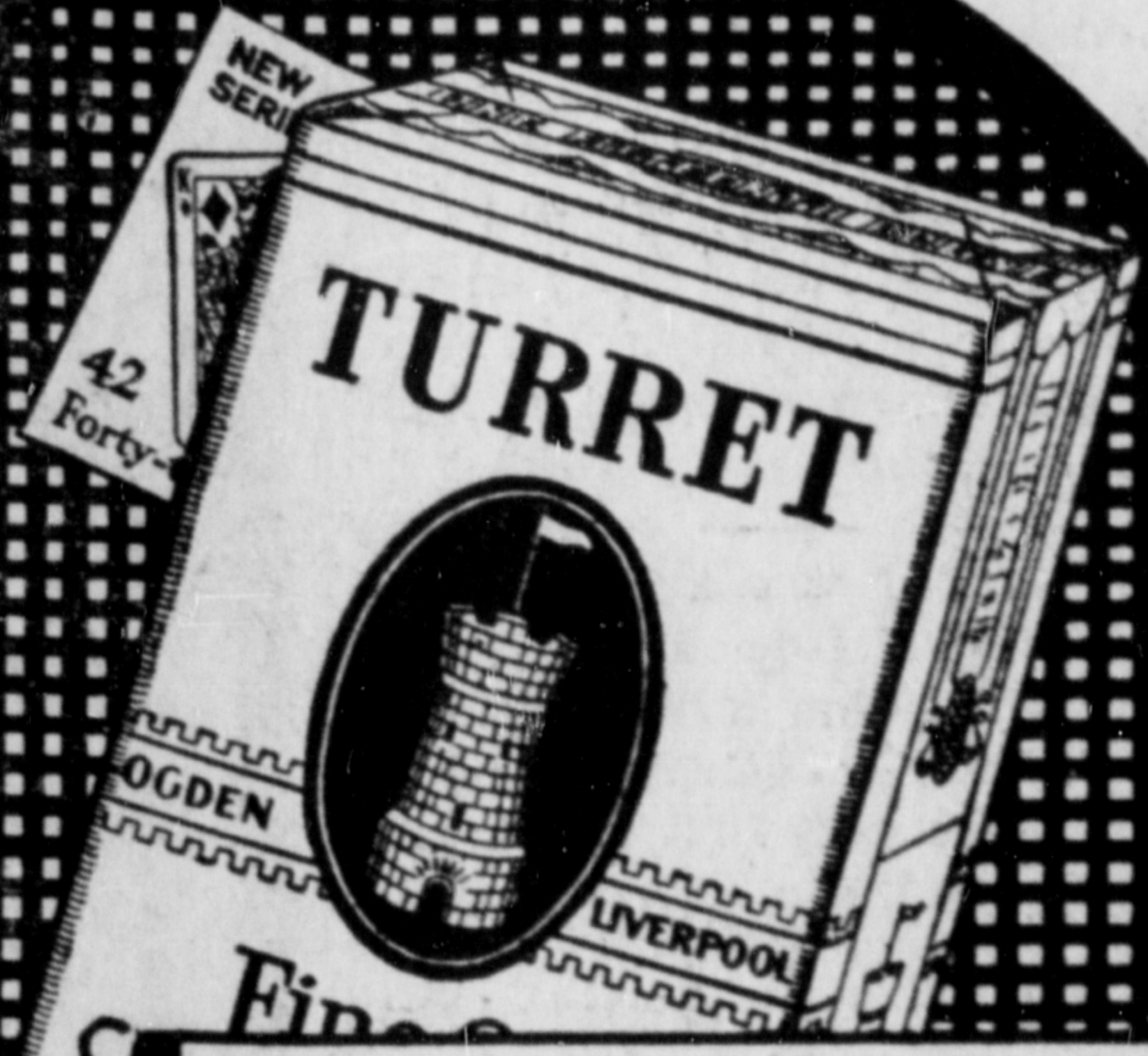

"The Witching Hour" Offered At
