The Associated Press of the United States gives the outstanding news stories of last year as Hauptmann's arrest, King Alexander's assassination, Hitler's blood purge, shooting of Dillinger, death of Dolfuss, birth of the Dionne guintuplets, the Morro Castle disaster, the Democratic offyear victory, the San Francisco general strike and the Inaultrial.

Most people will not agree with the Associated Press in regard to its choice. The shooting of a bandit should not be an outstanding event although it had considerable local interest for the people of the United States. The choice was made not in regard to relative importance but buased on the reaction of the public in the matter of general interest.


