| 1/2 cup butter | 1 1/2 cups sugar | icing |
| 3 eggs | 2 cups flour | 4 squares chocolate |

Cream the butter and sugar, add the yolks of the eggs and beat until light. Add flour sifted with the baking powder; also the Nestlé's Evaporated Milk, and flavouring; beat until light.
