WORK ON DIGBY MARINE DEPOT

Marine Depot will be One of Most Important on Pacific Town Equipped with Electric Light, Water and Sewer System.

The Pacific Coast Construction Company is making rapid strides on the erection of the Marine Depot for the Department of Marine and Fisheries, and the Digby Island station, because of its delightful location, surroundings and modern improvements, bids fair to be one of the most coveted posts in Canada.

Where but a few months ago stood the primeval forest there now stands a miniature city, with all the conveniences of a metropolis, as the station can boast of its own water works, sewer system, heating and lighting plant, as well as telegraphic and wireless connections.

The commanding site overlooking the harbor is occupied by the residence of the chief engineer, a commodious dwelling equipped with every modern convenience. Below it stands the double dwelling of the assistant engineers, the clerk's house, office, and men's dwelling. Other buildings occupying the flat below are the power house, with an eighty-five foot reinforced concrete chimney, the buoy shed of steel superstructure, carbide shed, machine shops, steel water tower and store.

A large concrete wharf 400 feet long by forty feet wide, built of the Pacific Coast Construction Company's patent ferro-concrete piles, is now under construction. The piles are being driven braced with reinforced concrete braces. This will undoubtedly be one of the strongest, most durable and scientifically constructed wharves on the Pacific Coast. A 56 pound steel rail track will run from the buoy shed out upon the wharf for the purpose of handling the heavy boys, etc.

The harbor of Casey Cove has been well dredged thus allowing vessels of any tonnage access to the wharf.
