Timely Recipes

Beat egg yolks and whites separately. Add the cornstarch mixed with the milk to the yolks, also the salt and pepper. Stir in the melted butter. Last fold in the stiffly beaten whites. Have a heaping tablespoon of oil, butter substitute or butter heated hot in an iron skillet. Turn in omelette mixture. Cook over a moderate fire. When firm fold one-half over the other and serve at once on a heated platter. Jelly, minced ham, parsley or onions may be added to this omelette before folding.
