## TO PREVENT STRIKES

### Bill to be Introduced in British Parliament

London, Sept. 22.—Will Crooks, Labor member of Parliament, has drafted a bill which is designed to prevent strikes and lockouts.

The measure provides that any employee declaring a lockout or any employees going on strike in violation of the act shall be punished by fine. The employer, if the bill becomes law, is to be fined from \$100 to \$1000 for every day that such a lockout continues. The penalty for striking contrary to the act ranges from \$10 to \$50 a day, and persons inciting employees to strike are liable to a fine varying from \$50 to \$1000.

The measure further proposes that wherever a dispute arises between an employer and any of his employees, and they are unable to settle it, either party may apply to the Board of Trade for the appointment of a "board of conciliation and investigation," to which the dispute may be referred. Authority to strike or lock out must come from the Board of Trade.

## SPARKING PARLORS

### Pastor Believes They Would Reduce Divorce Cases

"If someone will give me \$5,000 or even \$2,000, I will equip for Hoboken a resort for lovers which will insure the young people here against divorce and render their married lives happy and content—something that fifty per cent of the marriages now performed are not."

This is the statement made by the Rev. Joseph D. Peters, pastor of the First Reformed church of Hoboken, N. J., who has been concerning himself a great deal lately with the social welfare of the young people of the New Jersey city. He has found that a large number of divorces annually are attributed to incompatibility of temper and other reasons which, according to Dr. Peters, "might just as well have been discovered before marriage as after."

"Therefore, I propose to equip some place where these young people can come and talk and play games and learn each other's dispositions and see if they are really suited to each other. If the woman shows that she is fond of luxuries which the men cannot afford, or if he displays a disposition to cheat her at dominoes or cards, then they will know that they have no business getting married."
