Bringing general freight cargo for local delivery, C. N. R. steamer Prince John, Capt. James Watt, arrived in port at midnight last night from Vancouver and on Monday will be taken on the pontoons at the local dry dock for annual overhaul prior to being placed on the Queen Charlotte Islands service for the winter. On Saturday night of next week she will sail for Vancouver via the Islands in place of the ss. Prince Charles which will be withdrawn from service here and tied up at the local dry dock.

Completing the company's final voyage of the season on tourist schedule to Alaska, C.P.R. steamer Princess Louise, Capt. S. K. Gray, is due in port at 3:30 this afternoon from Skagway and other northern points and will sail at 5 p.m. for Vancouver. The Princess Louise will be here again northbound on the company's first voyage on fall schedule to Alaska on Wednesday morning of next week.

Bringing in as round trip passengers, W. J. Crawford, well known Stewart transportation man, and Hugh J. MacDonald, general road foreman for the Portland Canal district, the Pacific Airways Junkers seaplane, at present based at Stewart in commercial aviation, arrived here from Stewart at 3:30 yesterday afternoon, hopping off on her return north about 7 p.m.
