(1.) Employers, respecting salaries and wages paid to employees during the calendar year 1934.

(2.) Every person in receipt of salary, wages, or investment income.

These Returns are required to be filed not later than

FEBRUARY 28th, 1935

Taxpayers' should obtain forms from any Provincial Government office or chartered bank in the Province.

An urgent request is made for these Returns to be filed as much in advance of the final date as possible to enable the Department to give better service to taxpayers than can be provided during the rush of the last day.

Corporation, business, or professional income is required to be returned within three months after the end of the taxpayer's fiscal year.

C. N. R. steamer Prince Charles moved down from the dry dock to the Canadian National wharves yes-

terday and, under command of Capt. Neil McLean, will sail tonight on regular schedule for Vancouver via the Queen Charlotte Islands, taking over the run of the Prince John which is being tied up here for overhaul. The Prince Charles will probably remain on the run from now until next fall.

C. P. R. steamer Princess Adelaide, Capt. James Flood, arrived in port at 2 o'clock this afternoon from the south and will sail at 10 p.m. on her return to Vancouver and way-points.

The British steamer Frumenton is due in port on Sunday from the Orient to load a full cargo of grain from the Alberta Wheat Pool's local elevator for delivery to the United Kingdom or Continent. More definite word as to the exact time of arrival is looked for any time now. New grain continues to move from the prairies to the local house but not in as large quantities as a few weeks ago. Fourteen cars of grain came in last night.

There were thirty-three passengers aboard the steamer Princess Norah which was in port yesterday afternoon southbound from Skagway to Vancouver. One person disembarked from the vessel here while three went south from this port aboard her.
