FARES TO IDS. CUT

Steamship Company Announces Reduction From Here to Massett Inlet Points

Effective August 1 there will be a reduction in steamship passenger fares from Prince Rupert to Massett Inlet points, it is announced by Canadian National Steamships. The first class one way fare will be \$5 and round trip \$9. The deck class one way fare will be \$4 and round trip \$8 with the Indian deck fare \$3.50 and \$7 round trip. No meals or berth are included in these fares.

The present one way single first class fare, including meals and berth, is \$9 with the deck class fare \$5.25 and Indian deck class, \$3.75.

Children Again In Trouble For Petty Thieving

A number of young boys, who have already been in similar trouble, have fallen into the hands of the police again in connection with further incidents of breaking and entering in various parts of the city. Some of them had been out on suspended sentence. Some have already been in industrial school. Goods in all cases have been recovered and charges are pending against the young culprits two of whom are being held in jail. Some of the children involved are of quite tender years. There has been a great deal of trouble of this sort around town lately and it appears that the authorities are going to be forced to take decisive action to put an end to it. The children do not appear to have any respect for warnings from the police or the court.
