**Timely Recipes**

**BRAN BRAUNSCHWEIGER**  
 Two cups brown sugar, 1/2 cup honey, 1/4 cup butter, 1 tbs. grated lemon rind, - tbs. lemon juice, 1 egg, 1/2 cup milk, 1 cup bran, 3 1/2 cups flour, 1 tsp. cinnamon, 1/4 tsp. cloves, 1/4 tsp. mace, 1 tsp. soda.  
 Mix brown sugar, honey and butter. Melt over low heat carefully. Add lemon rind and juice. Cool to room temperature. Beat egg well, add milk and bran. Add to first mixture. Sift remaining dry ingredients together and add. Mix well. Chill dough thoroughly. Roll out dough to one-eighth inch in thickness and cut into 2-inch squares. Bake in a moderate oven (350 degrees F.) from 10 to 12 minutes.  
 Yield: 7 dozen cookies 2 inches square.  
 Note: These cookies should be stored for a few days since it improves the flavor.


