### BORROWING FROM OTTAWA

It is rather good news that British Columbia will meet her own obligations next month instead of having to ask Ottawa to loan the money. Premier Pattullo is not in Ottawa asking for loans. He is asking for an adjustment of the relations between the province and the federal government which will enable the provincial government to pay its own debts in an honorable manner. If the federal government took over the Pacific Great Eastern Railway there would be no need of asking loans or if the Dominion government would make up to the province an allowance for the huge sums of money sent east in customs dues or in payment for articles such as motor vehicles on which this province is taxed huge sums due to the protective tariff, sums which Ontario and Quebec do not have to pay owing to their nearness to the point of production. The western provinces pay to enable the eastern central provinces to make money.



### FRENCH ELECTIONS GO TO LEFT

The people of France have voted more communistic than they did at the previous election. They have made a treaty with Russia for protection against possible attack from Germany, their hereditary enemy, and as a protest against Hitlerism they have gone to the other extreme.

It is very difficult for a Canadian to understand the politics of France. That country has for several years been pouring arms and ammunition across the border into Germany, material which they feel may quite possibly be used against themselves. The prosperity of France and Germany depend one upon the other. They are necessary to each other and yet they hate and fear each other and there is continuous talk of war between them.

Just now France is feeling badly to think the Germans have cut off the shackles of Versailles. That country has thrown in her lot with Russia and for that reason alone a leftist vote was to be expected. What we in this country cannot understand is how the same person can be expected to hold the position of prime minister as suggested, especially when he is so closely related to the big interests of the country and particularly the armament interests.

The Indians now have a full game margin over the second place Boston Red Sox.

In the National League, the Cincinnati Reds and Chicago Cubs played a ten inning game at Cincinnati to break their tie for second place, the Reds winning 5 to 4 to take the runner-up position exclusively, a game and a half behind the New York Giants, while the Cubs dropped into a tie with Brooklyn Dodgers for third place.
