Substitutes For Foreign Goods

Dec. 14: (CP)-Ger-1 many's economic independence in magautical products, contemted in Chancellor Hitler's fouror plan, is discussed in an article in the Voelkischer Beobanchter, in which the pharmaceutical "Feuhrer," Dr. Schmierer, shows that many products now imported can be made in Germany.
