
## Mussolini Talks Peace, Threatens War, Defies Britain, Scores League in Latest Blast





Mussolini, fascist dictator of Italy, who a little earlier paradoxically spoke of Italy's "olive branch" emerging from a forest of 8,000,000 bayonets, has come forward with another sensation, this time threatening Britain's sea and air supremacy and demands recognition for Ethiopia in return for Britain's safe passage through the Mediterranean. Simultaneously, Il Duce announces that Italy will

build new ships and naval bases to match England's and will increase its naval personnel to 100,000 men. In his most recent harangue to half a million blackshirts in Milan, Mussolini ridiculed the League of Nations and the principle of collective security. 
