

# Five Military Flying Boats to be Added to R.C.A.F.



Five military flying boats, exactly similar to the one shown here flying over the east coast of Britain, will be built for the Royal Canadian Air Force by Canad an Victors Ltd. of Montreal. They are Vickers' super-marine long-distance craft of the Stanr or type the fastest all-metal flying boat in the British Air Force. Equipped with two engines, and carrying a crew of five, they can be used for reconnaissance, bombing, torpedo transportation, or for navigation instruction, and accommodation can be afforded for sleeping and cooking on heard. The new boats will cost \$780,000, and have a top speed of 150 miles an hour. Pressure of British government requirements prevented Canada from securing construction of the flying boats in British factories, where most R.C.A.F. equipment is built.
