PLYMOUTH, Eng., March 31: (CP)-"Let me die 26 sea, where I have lived most of my life—then I shall be happy," was a request made by Captain Thomas J. Henderson, master of the British India steamer Arankola, when in hospital at Calcutta he was warned that probably he would never again see his home at South Shields, England.

At the point of death Captain Henderson was carried on board the liner Modasa, bound for Plymouth, England. He died while the Modasa was calling at Madras The body was transferred to a tug which steamed out to sea. where the coffin was consigned to the deep with the usual ritual of ocean burial.
