Scheme Proposed is not Complete Trunk Sewer Yet. Will be After Dry Dock is Further Advanced.

Plans of the proposed new trunk sewer to be constructed along the line of Hays Creek are on view at the City Hall today. The work which is to cost \$75,000 involves the building of sewers from a point near No. 8 Comox avenue, to the temporary outfall not far from where the salt water meets fresh in Hays Creek. Later on the plans include the laying of sewers from that temporary outfall to the sea, but until the new dry dock and ship yards are more advanced in construction this part of the work must be deferred. There is also an extension provided for landwards along Comox 2 avenue a good deal farther than the present planned construction
