Deschenes was also a director and president of the Bethel Granite Railway Co., and a director and vice-president of the following affiliated companies: Centmont Corporation; Brooks & Sons Inc.; and Central Vermont Terminal Inc.

He was a director of the New London Northern Railroad Co.; Central Vermont Transportation Co.; Vermont and Province Line Railway Co.; and vice-president of the Montreal and Vermont Junction Railway Co.; Montreal and Province Line Railway Co.; and the Stanstead, Shefford and Chambly Railroad Co.

Under his stewardship, the Central Vermont has been kept in the vanguard of transportation progress in New England. He was responsible for pioneering the development of merchandise freight collection and delivery service, coordination of rail and bus service and coordinated rail and airways service.

Worked for Community

Mr. Deschenes gave liberally of his time, experience and energy to civic and community development of his native city and state and was active in the development of winter and summer recreational activities in Vermont. He was an influential member of the Vermont State Chamber of Commerce and the New England Council. He was also so widely known in New England banking circles through his long association with the Weldon National Bank in St. Albans, of which he has served as managing director during the past four years.

The funeral will be held at St. Albans on Friday morning.

From the Waterfront**

Midnight tonight will mark the deadline for issuance of clearances to halibut vessels for Area No. 3 this season. A reasonable time will be allowed the vessels to leave after clearing. The boats are to be given a full opportunity to complete final catches.

Two western halibut boats landed catches at Seattle yesterday as follows: Polaris, 39,000 pounds, Whiz, 11½ and 9; Sunset, 46,000 pounds, San Juan 11½ and 9. Three local cod boats sold small incidental catches at 13c per pound.

Capt. Paul Armour returned last night from North Island with the boat John Essler. He brought the Union Oil Co.'s tank scow which has been stationed on the North Island trolling grounds during the summer and which will now be taken to Vancouver.

NEWSPAPER TALE HERE

"Exclusive" and "Wild and Woolly," With Jane Withers, on Double Bill at Capitol Theatre

The scene is an old frontier town but big city gangsters are introduced in the picture which is said to be a real pan-demonium-maker.
