

## Synopsis of Land Act

ch can be obtained free of charge by ddressing the Department of Lands, Vicon. Victoria, or any Government Agent. Records will be granted covering only land suitable for agricultural purposes within reasonable distance of road, school and marketing facilities and which is not berland, i.e., carrying over 5,000 board feet per acre east of the Coast Range and .000 feet per acre west of that Range.

Applications for pre-emptions are to be addressed to the Land Commissioner of the Land Recording Division in which the forms obtained from the Commissioner. years and improvements made to value of \$10 per acre, including clearing and cultivating at least five acres, before a Crown Grant can be received.


