### WHIFFLETS From the Waterfront

Following the announcement by the International Fisheries Commission of the tentative final date for issuance of clearances to halibut fishing in Area No. 3, the halibut control board of Seattle is relaxing the voluntary regulations in regard to lay-overs in port between trips, etc. Vessels now in port on lay-overs may leave at once and, under certain conditions, lay-overs may not now be required. The fishing limit of 3500 pounds per man per trip remains unchanged.

Two halibut boats sold catches in Seattle yesterday as follows: Thor, 39,000 pounds, San Juan, 12¼c and 10c; Arne, 21,000, Whiz, 12¼c and 10c.

Union steamer Cardena, Capt. John Boden, is due in port about 10 o'clock tonight from the south and is scheduled to sail half an hour later on her return to Vancouver and way points.

The Seattle yacht Nikinah, with its owner, Wesley B. MacDonald and party on board, was here again from Monday evening to Tuesday morning of this week on its way south after a cruise up the coast as far as Ketchikan.

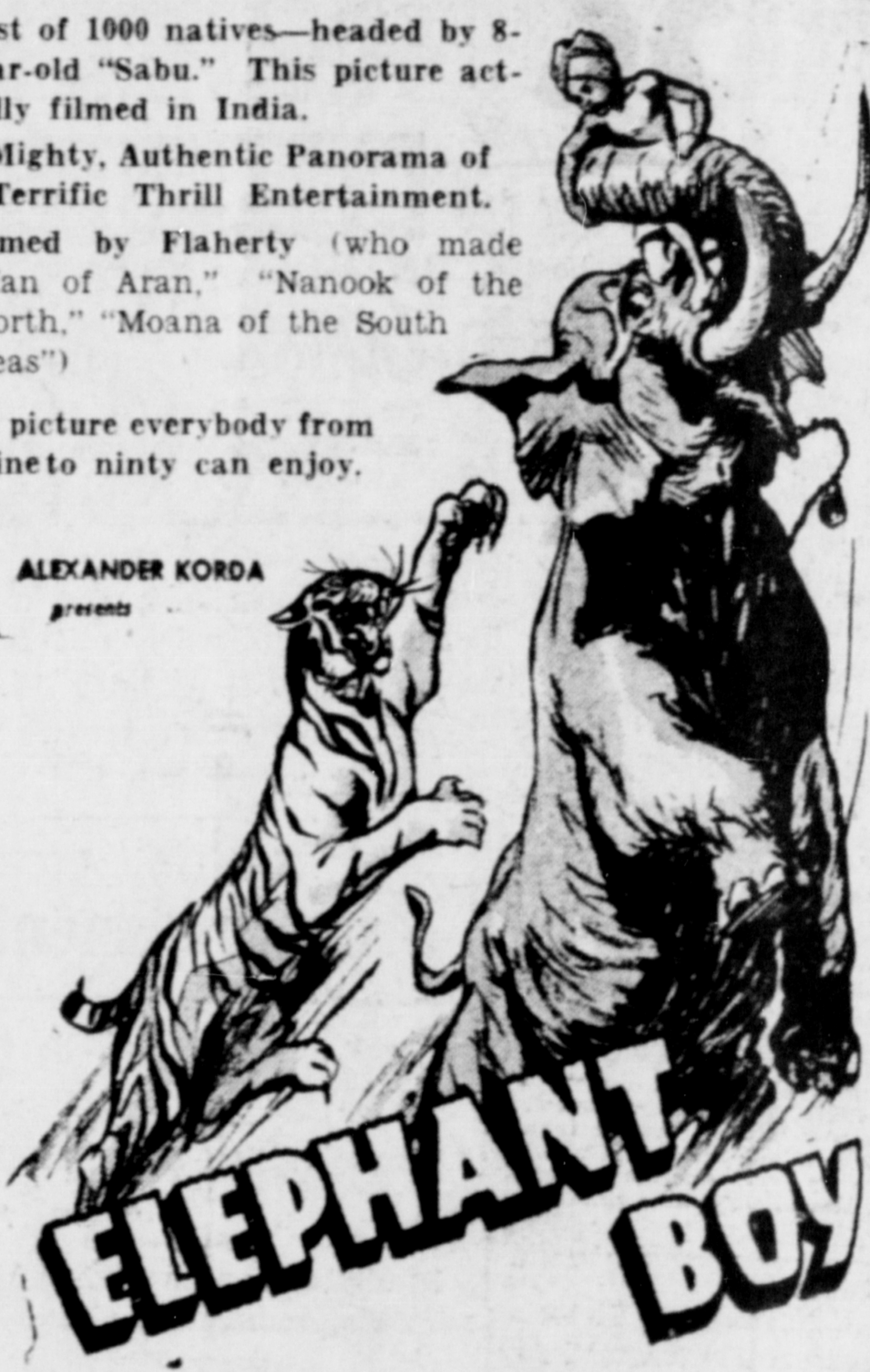
