

Because it is so close, relatively speaking, Jupiter is vails over the interior. now unusually bright, and can easily be located in the southeastern sky during the evening. At 9 o'clock in N. W. winds, fine and moderately -by a nurse! the evening it is directly south.

The earth encircles the sun at an average distance of lott Islands - Moderate shifting 92,870,000 miles, while that of Jupiter is 483,200,000 miles. winds, mostly fair and cool with But instead of going around the sun once a year, like some showers. the earth, Jupiter goes around in nearly twelve years.

Thus, in a period about a month longer than a year the earth comes on the same side of the sun as Jupiter, and then the two bodies are nearest. This is called "opposition" because Jupiter and the sun are then in opposite directions, and this is what happened last week. A little over six months from now the earth will be on the side of the sun away from Jupiter, and then the planets will be separated by about 586,000,000 miles. Because the orbits of the two planets are not exactly round, this distance varies, and they can get 600,000,000 miles apart.

Jupiter is the largest planet of the solar system, with a diameter of 86.720 miles, about eleven times that of the earth. It is believed that we cannot see any solid surface but only the tops of clouds of frozen carbon dioxide and methane, materials which are gaseous at the far higher temperatures prevailing here.
