NEW YORK BUILDING CAR HERE IS AHEAD

New York Man and His Family Visiting City After Trans-continental Drive

Value for Year to Date More Than Twice That of Last Year Despite Light August

A big Lincoln touring car, bearing a New York licence plate and the dust of many miles of transcontinental travelling, is a rather unusual sight on the streets of Prince Rupert today. The car of but \$800 which, at that, was that of A. H. Ehrenclaw of New York City who brought it in on last night's train from Hazelton after having driven across the continent accompanied by his wife and four children. They will proceed to Vancouver tonight aboard the steamer Cardena, taking the car with them.

Building permits for the month of August in Prince Rupert amounted to the slim total of \$225 in August last year. So far this year permits have reached a total of \$21,249. Two permits were issued in August—one to V. Lewis for the construction of a workshop at a cost of \$75 and the other to John Watson for repairs to his residence on Fifth Avenue East amounting to \$225.

Mr. Ehrenclaw would have welcomed the opportunity to have been able to say that he had reached Alaska in the course of his long trip but it was, of course, impossible to drive there and it would have taken too long to go north from here by boat although he was still considering doing so this morning.

This is probably the first New York licensed car ever to be seen here.

Timely Recipes**CHEESE SOUP**

Four cups milk, 2 or 3 slices onion, 2 tablespoons butter, 2 tablespoons flour, 1 teaspoon salt, ½ teaspoon pepper, ¾ cup grated cheese, yolks of 2 eggs.

Scald milk with onion. Remove onion. Melt butter in top part of double boiler. Blend in flour. Add hot milk and seasonings and stir constantly until mixture thickens. Cook five minutes. Add beaten egg yolks. Cook one minute and add grated cheese. Beat with egg beater and serve at once. Egg yolks may be omitted but they make a richer and more delicious soup.
