WOMAN'S CROWNING GLORY SOME XMAS RIDDLES

Any Woman, by Cultivation, Can Obtain Thick, Glossy Tresses. Errain Sharpeners for the Kiddies to Practice With.

Without doubt one of woman's greatest glories is her hair, and unless that is long, and thick, and glossy, she is really never quite satisfied with it.

Correct and systematic brushing is one of the most important factors in producing a really fine head of hair. At least ten minutes should be spent on brushing every day—five minutes at night and five minutes in the morning.

Don't just brush the surface of the hair, but use a long-haired (but not too hard) brush, so that the bristles will penetrate to the scalp. It is necessary to get as near the roots of the hair as possible if brushing is to have any beneficial results.

It is not necessary to brush with a great deal of vigor; if you do that you will probably bring out large quantities of your hair, instead of promoting its growth.

Use your brush firmly, but not roughly—in such a manner that you set the blood circulating more freely, but not so as to make your head ache with the violence of "stroke."

The proper way to brush your hair at night is to part it in the middle, or brush it smoothly down either side, then plait it loosely in two plaits, leaving the ends free. In the morning brush in the same way, and finish the "dressing," using your brush instead of your comb, as far as possible.

Your comb ought to be one of those large toothed variety, and should be used almost exclusively for taking out tangles. Massage is another excellent thing for making the hair grow. Press two fingers of both hands firmly on the scalp, just above the ears, and move it backward and forward several times; then move the fingers toward the front of the head and repeat the exercise.

ver the scalp once every day. It is a marvelous remedy for weak, falling hair. The massage may be helped by the use of a little vaseline, say, about twice a week. If your hair is rather greasy then use the vaseline less often and only a very little at a time.

Another excellent hair tonic is plain paraffin oil. There are two drawbacks to paraffin, however, namely: That it is highly inflammable and therefore you must keep away from any artificial heat or light after using it, and that it has rather an unpleasant odor.

The latter drawback is one that is soon remedied, however, as the odor vanishes very quickly, especially if you can go bareheaded into the open air for half an hour or so after using the oil. Don't apply it oftener than once a week.

It is better not to wash your hair too often, unless it is very oily. Once in three weeks is quite often enough. It is an excellent plan to give the scalp a good massage with vaseline just before washing your hair. One other thing: give your hair as much sun and air as possible. When you can conveniently do so let it fall loosely round your shoulders so that the air may get through it and cool the scalp.
