Taxing Bachelors is Very Good Sport in Argentina.

Bachelors are heavily taxed in one of the provinces of the Argentine Republic. Between the ages of twenty and thirty he must pay \$5 a month; after the age of thirty, \$10; when he is between thirty-five and fifty, \$20; between fifty and seventy-five, \$30. When a widower has been three years wifeless he must remarry or pay the tax. If, however, he can prove that he has been thrice refused as a husband within one year he is not taxed.

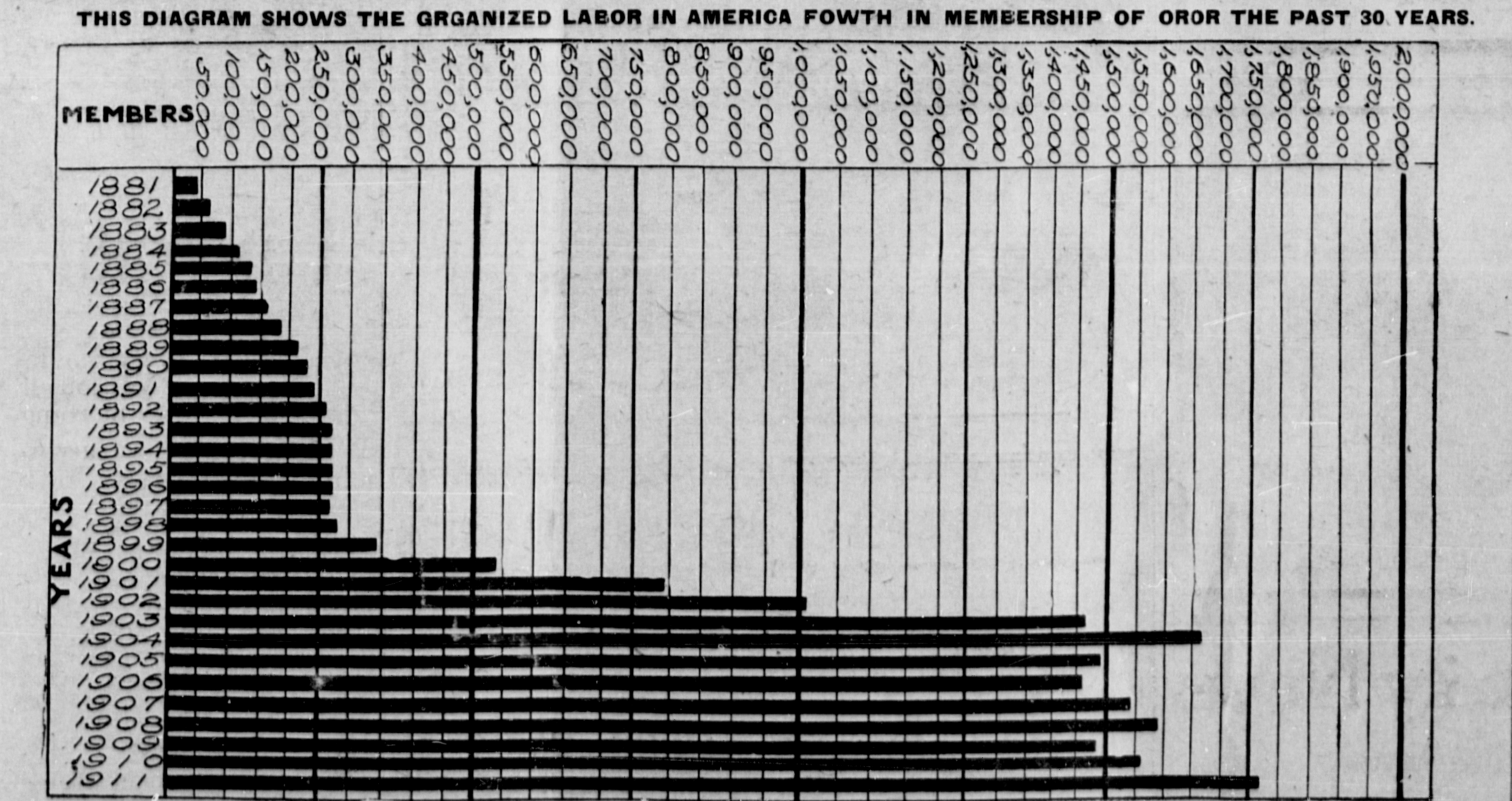
A JAPANESE DARLING.
